Permits protect Property Owners from mistakes that are either intentional or unintentional.

*If you are planning on buying a home and apply for a mortgage & the house you want to buy does not have the proper permits in place, your mortgage could be declined.

*If you own a shop on your property and you did not get the right permits, your insurance company may decline coverage should something happen to it.
