## **Policy**

The County of Two Hills has established, by By-Law No. 6-87 a Committee consisting of the Reeve, the County Administrator and the Superintendent of Public Works and has delegated to them the powers specified in Section 14 of the Motor Transport Act, including the implementation of road bans.

The Committee has the power and authority with respect to rural roads or streets to:

- a) Prohibit the use by a traction engine or public vehicle for a period or periods that the Committee determines.
- a) Limit or restrict the speed of a traction engine or public vehicle for a period or periods that the Committee determines.
- c) Increase, limit or restrict the maximum gross weight that may be borne by a tire, an axle or an axle group, or any of them, or the maximum gross weight that may be borne by a vehicle or a combination of vehicles for a period or periods that the committee determines.
- d) Cause signs to be erected as the Committee considers necessary to notify persons using the road of the prohibition, limitation, increase or restriction imposed.
