## Land Approach Policy

**Title:** Land Approach

**Authority:** Public Works Department

**Policy Statement:** The County of Two Hills may Construct Approaches to Landowners

**Purpose:** To Establish Standard Procedures for Construction of Approaches

### Procedure:

1. Requests for new approaches, relocation of existing approaches and widening of existing approaches shall be made to the Public Works Supervisor of the County in writing.
2. Requests for new approaches, relocation of existing approaches and widening of existing approaches will only be considered adjacent to a developed road.
3. The Landowner will be responsible to supply all the dirt required, which shall be within 100 meters distance from the approach.
4. The County of Two Hills will provide at its convenience one approach and adequate culvert if deemed necessary per quarter section or part thereof if naturally severed.
5. New approaches required because of subdivisions, will be the responsibility of the developer as well as culverts if deemed necessary by the County.
6. Requests to relocate an existing approach shall be inspected to ensure the new location is safe.
7. The County will provide at its convenience the necessary equipment to remove the old approach and construct the new approach.
8. The Landowner shall provide all the dirt needed for the new approach and the required culvert, should the old existing culvert not be reusable.
9. The County will provide at its convenience the equipment and manpower necessary to widen an approach.
10. The Landowner shall provide all the dirt needed and the required culvert extension for approach widening.
11. Existing approach(es) on newly constructed roads will be replaced by the County.
