PUBLIC WORKS SNOW REMOVAL

With the onset of winter, the Public Works Department would like to remind residents that the snow plowing of driveways will be available to full-time residents that qualify.

As part of the snow clearing policy: **BUS ROUTES WILL BE GIVEN FIRST PRIORITY FOLLOWED BY COUNTY ROADS** before driveways are cleared, so please be patient as the Snow Clearing Crew will do their best to reach qualifying residents in a timely manner.

SENIORS:
\$100 per year

FULL-TIME RESIDENTS:
\$250 per annum after November 1

CUSTOM SNOW PLOWING:
Flat fee of \$200, additional hours as per Fees Schedule.
Fees do not change if there is abundant snow or no snow (flags are no longer required)

Lastly, due to safety concerns, the County of Two Hills asks residents to fully clear County roads of residual snow left when clearing driveways. Leaving ridges is a driving hazard, should an accident occur the landowner is liable.
