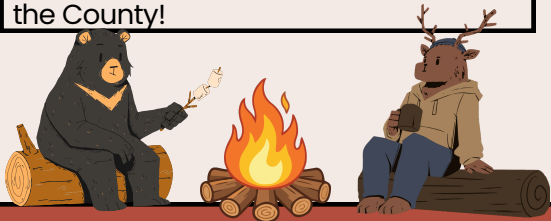

2% LIQUID STRYCHNINE AVAILABLE FOR SALE

2% Liquid Strychnine for control of Richardson Ground Squirrels is available at the County of Two Hills Agricultural Service Board Office @ \$20.00/bottle. This product is only available to bonified farmers, which means you have a farm fuel number and GST number.

There is a producer training requirement that farmers must complete online before being able to purchase Strychnine, follow this link: <https://sarm.ca/strychnine-stewardship-training/>

Farmers do have to follow proper protocol while handling/mixing 2% Liquid Strychnine.

An application form must be completed and signed indicating the legal land location(s) where the poison will be applied and that Best Management Practices will be followed.

ROADSIDE MOWING PROGRAM

It's that time of year again! The Agricultural Service Boards roadside mowing program is starting! The program will consist of mowing all road allowances with up to a 15-foot cut from the shoulder into the ditch.

Persons wishing to cut hay on a road allowance have to complete all cutting prior to the mowing arrival. If hay has been cut and is in swath, the mower will go around that swath. However, all standing grass will be mowed with absolutely no exceptions.

ROADSIDE SPRAYING PROGRAM

The County of Two Hills No. 21 Agricultural Service Board has started their Roadside Spraying Program along Municipal roads, as required, to control the spread of weeds and brush.

Landowners who do not want the ditches adjacent to their property sprayed can sign an annual "no spray agreement" stating that they accept responsibility for the control of weeds in the ditch along their property. No spray signs can be issued. It is your responsibility to ensure the no Spray Signs are in place and clearly visible during the entire County spray season. If you fail to control these weeds, the County may control them by whatever means they consider appropriate.
