Policy

The County of Two Hills wishes to provide ratepayers with the opportunity to purchase crushed gravel and will make crushed gravel available for sale for the ratepayers of the County of Two Hills (gravel deliveries must be within County boundaries). Additionally, the County wishes to protect its assets and ensure the safety of the County employees.

County Council will determine the rate at which gravel will be sold to County ratepayers as determined by resolution annually.

The County of Two Hills may also sell gravel to County employees (personal use only), at the discretion of the CAO.

County Council reserves the right to limit the amount of gravel to be sold to a maximum of 200 cubic yards per rural address annually within the County of Two Hills (resident may determine delivery location). Anything over 200 cubic yards will be at the discretion of Council. Additional gravel may be acquired by Public Works Supervisor's inspection and discretion.

Ratepayers can place their gravel order through the Public Works Department beginning April 1 and will be accepted as long as late season weather permits supply and delivery. The end date will be at the discretion of the Public Works Supervisor and/or designate.

Ratepayers will be allowed to choose from these non-spec categories:

- a) ½ inch crush gravel
- b) ¾ inch crush gravel
- c) 1 ½ inch crush gravel
- d) 2 inch crush gravel

All sales are dependent on surplus availability of product and ability to deliver the product (not to be used for resale).

Pick up date must be booked through Public Works Administration (Private delivery list will be supplied upon request).
